


Intelligent Oil Life Monitor

A smart way to keep your engine healthy



Trust your vehicle to alert you when it's time for an oil change.

Your vehicle's Intelligent Oil Life Monitor (IOLM) uses actual engine data and operating conditions, plus your driving habits, to calculate precisely when you need an oil change. In equipped vehicles, an instrument cluster message alerts you when it's time to change the oil and filter.

How do I check my Oil Life?

You can check your Oil Life percentage via FordPass or, in some vehicles, the Instrument Cluster.

*Dealers must reset the IOLM after every oil change as per the vehicle requirements.

When can I expect an alert?

The frequency of reminders to schedule an oil change depends on how you drive and the length of time since your last oil change. Below are the general guidelines.

Interval	Vehicle Use and Example
Greater than 15,000km	Optimal Optimal highway driving, use of Eco mode and avoidance of engine idling.
12,000 - 15,000km	Normal Normal commuting with some highway driving.
8,000 - 12,000km	Severe Moderate trailer towing, a lot of mountainous or off-road driving, or extended idling.
Up to 8,000km	Extreme Mostly short trip driving in extreme heat or cold, or trailer towing with maximum loads.

The FordPass Connect mobile app helps you easily stay on top of your vehicle's maintenance. Just one look and you will know the percentage of remaining oil life, plus you get automatic updates on your vehicle's health needs.

What's my vehicle telling me?

Change Engine Oil Soon

- There is **5%** or less oil life left. Contact your Ford Dealership to schedule an oil change*.

Oil Change Required

- There is **0%** oil life remaining. The oil and filter need to be changed within **2 weeks or 800 km** of the message appearing to protect the engine.

FAQs

How do I know if my vehicle has the Intelligent Oil Life Monitor?

Most new Ford Vehicles are equipped with the Intelligent Oil Life Monitor. Check your owner's manual for details.

When do I schedule an oil change?

Your vehicle will alert you when your oil life has dropped to 5% or less. That's the right time to schedule an oil change. This may also be the right time to complete a service too, as advised by your Ford Dealer.

Could an oil change be required in between a service?

Yes. Depending on your vehicle use, an oil change may be required between general service intervals. Your Ford Dealer will complete the oil change and reset the IOLM.

How do I schedule an oil change?

Contact your Ford Dealer and let them know your intelligent oil life monitor has been triggered.

What other service items should be checked regularly?

Refer to the Service Portfolio in your vehicle to check the Scheduled Service items. This may vary depending on driving behaviour and conditions. Your Ford Dealer will also provide a Vehicle Health Report to outline the health of your Tyres, Brakes and Battery.

Why does my vehicle have an Intelligent Oil Life Monitor?

Oil life depends on how the engine is operated: do you idle a lot, what climate do you live in, do you tow? Various conditions influence how quickly the oil degrades in the engine and therefore the IOLM will alert you when the oil in your vehicle is ready to be changed.




